





















Instagram Advertisements







Animal Paradise




ANIMAL PARADISE

Animal Paradise in an Animal Rescue Sanctuary dedicated to providing the best of care and life to sick and injured animals both domestic and wild.



Our wild rescues are those who are sick or have been injured and are unable to live in the wild. Our goal is to be able to get them well enough to be released in the wild, and if they are unable they stay here at our sanctuary where they will be safe and well taken care of.

Who We Are

We are an animal sanctuary located in Bradford, Ontario, founded in 2019 by Sarah Greene. Since then we have worked with thousands of animals with the goal to heal and rehabilitate sick and injured animals of all kinds.

We are a non-profit organization and all of the money from adoptions and donations go 100% to dedicating top care to our rescues.

Our hundreds of volunteers and two dozen permanent staff work every day ensuring each and every animal gets the medical care, love, and any other necessities they need.

What We Do

We take in animals of both domestic and wild nature and bring them to our sanctuary to give them the care they desperately need. Some we find ourselves and others are brought in by members of the community.

We take in domestic animals from any situation, with any kind of injury or sickness. Some have come from loving owners who wish their pet to stay with us as they cannot afford their treatment, in which we give them right back to them once they are well again. Some come from abusive homes or are homeless in which we treat their illnesses/injuries, train them if needed, get them used to people again and once they are ready, will be available for adoption.

We also take in wild animals who were found either by us or members of the community. They come from many situations such as being abandoned by their pack, injuries from poaching or human error, and many others. Our goal is to heal and eventually release them back into their natural habitat. If they are unable to return to the wild we home them safely in our sanctuary with exact replicas of their habitats with acres of land.

Our Care

Our domestic animals include cats, dogs, birds, rabbits, ferrets, guinea pigs, horses, and many more. Each type of animal is kept in a large housing unit as well as separated spacious yards. Each animal receives all its necessary medical treatment and care as well as any regular care such as food, water, walks, playtime, baths and more. Housing units and yards are cleaned daily to ensure our animals have the best place possible to get well again.

Our wild animals include lions, wolves, leopards, snakes, squirrels, elephants and more. Each lives in a replicated habitat with acres of land and shelter. They too receive all necessary medical care and are attended to their basic needs every day. We ensure our wild animals DO NOT live in zoo-like enclosures to help them heal, be happy, and healthy.

Despite being out biggest goal, some wild animals are unable to return to the while as they may come to us at a young age and never adapt, or because their illness prevents them from living safely in the wild. In this case they stay with us having all of their needs taken care of every day.

Join our team of hundreds of volunteers ranging from veterinarians/students, high school/college/university students (non-veterinarian related programs), retirees, trained wild animal specialists, and many more. Gain education and knowledge on dozens of animals and spend your time doing something that will make the life of a vulnerable animal 100x better.

Our friendly, welcoming and accepting community works hard to ensure each new volunteer is properly trained and educated for whichever job they receive.

Each of our volunteers recieve extensive training and education to ensure they are properly equipped to deal with and care for every domestic animal. For our wild animals and medical responsibilities, we only hire volunteers with experience with these kinds of jobs to ensure the safety of both the volunteers and wild rescues.

Our volunteers are welcome to commit any time they have to working at our sanctuary whether its 30 minutes a week to 40 hours a week.

Responsibilities can include:

- Feeding the animals
- Giving medicine, therapies, etc
- Developing new ways to help care and treat rescues
- Spending time and playing with animals
- Going on rescue missions
- Returning to families/habitats
- Working with adoptions
- Guiding tours
- And much more!
